Eligibility Requirements:

- No course prerequisites
- A bachelor's degree from any regionally accredited institution in any discipline with a GPA of at least 3.0 at the bachelor's degree institution or in the last 60 semester or 90 quarter units, or a master's degree from any regionally accredited institution in any discipline with an overall GPA of 3.0
- A general understanding of computers and technology
- Access to a computer with Internet connection and appropriate software

Tuition:

Fees for the Open Classes program are \$474 per unit, and most courses are 3 units. The total cost for one 3-unit class is \$1,422 (plus any required course materials). Fees are subject to review and change.

Accreditation:

Courses offered in the Open Classes program are electives in our master's degree programs. Our Master of Library and Information Science degree program is fully accredited by the American Library Association. In addition, San José State University is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges.
