Admissions Requirements

- A bachelor's degree from any regionally accredited institution in any discipline with a GPA of at least 3.0
- A general understanding of computers and technology
- Access to a computer with Internet connection and appropriate software
- University-required English language proficiency exam scores
- A valid California Professional Clear Credential
- Basic Skills Authorization
- English Language Learner Authorization

Note: We do not require a GMAT or GRE test, letters of recommendation, or a résumé.

Fees

- Regular Session students (U.S. zip codes 939XX-958XX) pay tuition established by the California State University System.
- Special Session students (all other U.S. zip codes and international) pay \$596 USD per unit for Academic Year 2026-2027. Total program tuition cost is \$16,688 (28 units).

Note: Fees are subject to review and change. Scholarships and financial aid may be available.

The California Teacher Librarian Services Credential program is accredited by the State of California and meets the requirements for the California Teacher Librarian Services Credential. The MLIS program is fully accredited by the American Library Association. In addition, San José State University is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges.
