The San José State University School of Information is launching a **Human-Centered Artificial Intelligence** undergraduate certificate program in fall 2025.

This exciting new program offers SJSU Regular Session undergraduate students a fundamental overview of Artificial Intelligence (AI) technologies, principles, ethics, and implementation strategies. By learning how to integrate AI with human cognition and knowledge, students build the interdisciplinary skills that are increasingly important for the next generation of AI careers.

Hybrid Delivery

Students benefit from a hybrid delivery format that combines the flexibility of online learning with in-person opportunities to build networks and gain hands-on experience in Silicon Valley.

Engaging Courses

Students complete a total of three courses; two are required, and one is chosen from two elective course options. Nine total units are required to complete the certificate.

- Introduction to Human-Centered Artificial Intelligence* (ISDA 80)
- Ethics of Artificial Intelligence* (ISDA 81)
- Responsible Human Artificial Intelligence Interaction (ISDA 180)
- Artificial Intelligence and Knowledge Management (ISDA 181)
