Admissions Requirements

- A bachelor's degree from any regionally accredited institution in any discipline with a GPA of at least 3.0
- A general understanding of computers and technology
- Access to a computer with Internet connection and appropriate software
- University-required English language proficiency exam scores

Note: We do not require a GMAT or GRE test, letters of recommendation, or a résumé.

Fees

- Regular Session students (U.S. zip codes 939XX-958XX) pay tuition established by the California State University System.
- Special Session students (all other U.S. zip codes and international) pay \$568 USD per unit for Academic Year 2025-2026. Total program tuition cost is \$24,424 (43 units).

Note: Fees are subject to review and change. Scholarships and financial aid may be available.
