- A bachelor's degree from any regionally accredited institution in any discipline with a GPA of at least 2.8
- A general understanding of computers and technology
- Access to a computer with Internet connection and appropriate software
- University-required English language proficiency exam scores

Note: We do not require a GMAT or GRE test, letters of recommendation, or a résumé.

- Academic Year: 2025-2026
- \$622 per unit – 30 units in program
- Total program tuition cost: \$18,660
