Admissions Requirements:

Based in the heart of Silicon Valley, SJSU offers the perfect blend of in-person learning and convenient online courses.

- A bachelor's degree from an accredited institution with a minimum GPA of 3.0 in an undergraduate program (or last 60 semester/ 90 quarter units)
- A general understanding of computers and technology
- Access to a computer with Internet connection and appropriate software
- University-required English language proficiency exam scores
- Fall 2025 Admission is open to California residents only, nationally by Fall 2026

Note: We do not require a GMAT or GRE test, letters of recommendation, or a résumé.

Fees

Fees for the Master of Instructional Design and Technology program are \$622 USD per unit, for a total of \$21,148 (34 units).
