

Faculty Mentoring

Tenure track faculty have four forms of mentoring:

1. The Director is always available to discuss teaching and research and also ensures that the Dean of the College is aware of tenure track faculty work and progress. The Director meets formally with each tenure track faculty member at least once a year in order to review progress and checks in informally on a regular basis.
2. The Associate Director/Graduate Advisor is available to answer any administrative questions.
3. The Chair of the RTP Committee works closely with tenure track faculty on their dossier preparation and provides guidance on research and teaching.
4. A tenured faculty member is assigned by the Director to mentor each tenure track faculty member. However, tenure track faculty should feel free to approach **any** tenured faculty member for mentoring and guidance as needed/requested.

Lecturer Mentoring

Lecturers have **primarily** teaching and advising responsibilities. Mentoring is provided by:
